

Photography and Video Taping

At St. Joseph Parish, a Catholic wedding is a liturgical ceremony. Care must be taken to see that the Mass and the marriage rite are not disrupted by the taking of pictures or video. Care must be taken to see that the focus of the congregation is on the altar and not on you. We ask for and appreciate your cooperation with our requests, Thank you!

- ❖ Flash photos may be taken as the bridal party is processing into and out of the church. No flash pictures are allowed during the Mass or ceremony.
- ❖ Photographers and videographers may not enter the sanctuary area.
- ❖ Please do not roam about the church once the Mass or ceremony has begun.
- ❖ Videotaping may be done from a stationary camera in the choir loft.
- ❖ Please do not re-create moments that have already taken place such as the vows or ring exchange.
- ❖ Posed pictures may be taken in the church before and/or after the wedding. Pictures taken in church following a Saturday afternoon wedding must conclude by 3:00 p.m. to accommodate other regular weekend church services.
